There is no limit to different ways to advocate for those in need.

The area just in front of Heartland Hall is **THE** place for any team or small group to advocate for an issue dear to their heart. They use the space from the end of 1st service to 12:15 (or 15 minutes after last service) for one Sunday a month **OR** once a year **OR** any amounts available.

We offer this space **each** Sunday to expose the congregation to current issues. Team choose to hand out flyers about an upcoming event to encourage greater participation, have petitions ready to sign for actions to help the 'least of these', sign-up sheets to explain the event and obtain volunteers, stories of what you accomplished with the help of GCPC members or _____!

We encourage advocates to reduce the moment of advocacy to one specific idea and concrete action for the short time available to those who stop by. The table space is just 24" square – just enough to hold a laptop for a looping power point, or for someone to sign a petition or to have a handout available with points of action in relation to your issue your are advocating.

KAIROS mans the table the 1st Sunday of the month and Outreach has the 4rd Sunday of the month.

We publish the list of *Advocacies* for each Sunday in each Sunday Bulletin and the monthly GCPC newsletter.
